IF YOU PRINT THE FILE, FOUR PAGES, THE FINAL PICTURE IS COMPLETED BY ARRANGING EACH OF THE FOUR PRINTED SHEETS AS FOLLOWS.

FIRST OFF, TRIM EACH PAGE TO THE EDGES OF THE PRINTED IMAGE AS FOLLOWS :-

Page 1 trim left hand side and bottom

Page 2 trim right hand side and top

Page 3 trim right hand side and bottom

Page 4 trim left hand side and top

THEN ARRANGE THEM AS:-

Page 1 to TOP RIGHT

Page 2 to BOTTOM LEFT

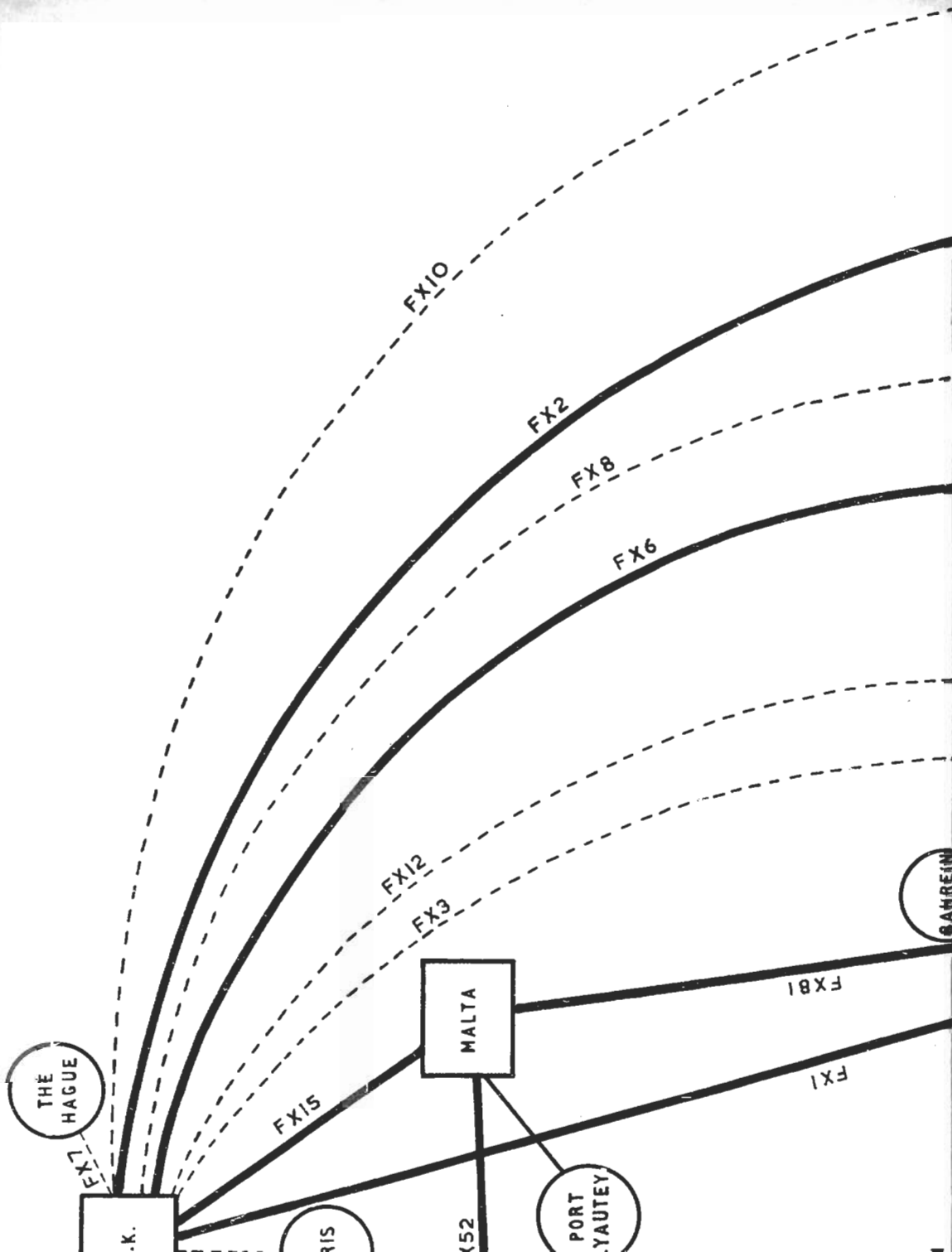
Page 3 to TOP LEFT

Page 4 to BOTTOM RIGHT

Glue or tape the four pages together to form the 'map' of the network, which was huge and truly global.

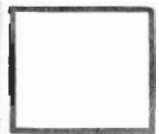
